- Submit immunization records for measles, mumps, and rubella if you were born after 1956 and for varicella (chicken pox) if you were born after 1979.
- After receipt of your application, information will be sent to you about arranging the computerized Basic Skills Assessment (BSA) required of all students prior to enrollment.

If you have taken the SAT or ACT, the BSA may be waived. Please check our website for details. A Waiver Request form must accompany SAT/ACT score documentation and includes information on course placement.

- Complete the Application for Admission and submit it with the \$20.00 Application Fee (if you applied to another CT community college, this fee is waived).

- Submit immunization records for measles, mumps, and rubella if you were born after 1956 and for varicella (chicken pox) if you were born after 1979.
- Submit transcripts of previous course work to determine if computerized Basic Skills Assessment (BSA) can be waived.

If you are in a degree/certificate program and need an official transfer evaluation:

Request an official transcript(s) from previous college(s) to be sent to QVCC Admissions office.

Fill out and submit the Transfer Credit Evaluation Request form found on the website.

Complete the Application for Admission. The \$20 fee is waived.

- Submit any outstanding records required for registration including:
 - Proof of high school or GED completion.
 - Immunization records, if needed.

Start your Education at Quinebaug Valley Community College

These programs offer seamless in-state transfer to a bachelor's degree, saving you time and money. With a QVCC education, you have the ability to transfer to both in-state and out-of-state colleges and universities. Individual program advising will help you align your course of study at QVCC with the four year degree you plan to pursue.

Transfer Compact Dual Admission Program with Connecticut State Universities

Start your degree at Quinebaug Valley Community College and finish at Eastern, Central, Southern or Western Connecticut State University. With this program you can take advantage of guaranteed admissions to the state university, coordinated academic advising from community college and university advisors, library access, priority registration and a smooth transition into your bachelor's degree program.

To participate, you must apply to the Dual Admission Program before accruing 15 transferable credits. For more information contact our Student Success Center and speak to an advisor or a member of our admissions staff.

Connecticut State University Pathway Transfer Degrees

TAP (Transfer Articulation Pathways – also known as "Transfer Tickets") transfer directly to Connecticut State Universities and Charter Oak State College without losing any credits. You are guaranteed full junior status upon transferring. All associate level courses required for these transfer degrees will count toward your bachelor's degree. UCONN Guaranteed Admission Program (GAP)

This program guarantees your admission to UCONN's School of Business, College of Liberal Arts & Sciences, and College of Agriculture, Health and Natural Resources. You can choose from over 70 majors at UConn.

To be eligible, you must enroll prior to earning 30 credits and be enrolled in Liberal Arts & Sciences at QVCC. To qualify, you must earn a 3.0 minimum (3.3 for School of Business) cumulative grade point average and an associate degree in the Liberal Arts transfer program.

College of Technology

As part of the Connecticut College of Technology (COT), the Engineering Science associate degree provides a seamless pathway (with automatic acceptance, full transfer of credit, and junior/third-year status) for graduates who transfer to COT universities including the University of Connecticut, the University of Hartford, Central Connecticut State University, the University of New Haven and Fairfield University.

The Technology Studies associate degree program also provides a seamless pathway for graduates who transfer to COT universities including Eastern Connecticut State University, the University of Hartford and Central Connecticut State University.

A 3.0 minimum cumulative GPA and an associate degree in Engineering Science or Technology Studies is needed for most COT transfer pathways, but GPA requirements do vary. See QVCC's Program Coordinator for more details.
