MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Master's degree in mathematics or related areas; preference given to candidates with at least two years of teaching experience at a community college and a keen interest in teaching upper level courses including Pre-Calculus, Calculus I, II & III and Differential Equations. Candidates must be committed to learning in a variety of formats, proficient in using instructional technology, skilled in teamwork, capable of working with diverse students, and able to contribute to credit programming. QVCC faculty members are key contributors to the life of the College in and beyond the classroom.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications as stated are encouraged to put in writing precisely how their background and experience have prepared them for the responsibilities of this position and providing appropriate references.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Under the supervision of the Dean of Academic Affairs and Student Services or designee, the candidate will be responsible for instruction in mathematics from developmental through college level mathematics, with the majority of classes assigned in the upper levels; curriculum development; recruiting, hiring, and supervising adjuncts; professional development; College committee work; system-wide committee work; student advising; and other related duties.
