## ***The QVCC Foundation is pleased to offer the following scholarships for the 2021-2022 academic year.***

### **Who Can Apply**

Most scholarships are available to students who will attend QVCC in the 2021-2022 academic year and have a GPA of 3.0 or better. Students may also use their scholarships in summer of 2021 or winter intersession of 2022.

Part-time students are eligible and must be enrolled in two or more classes. We recommend that scholarship applicants carefully review individual scholarship criteria.

### **When to Apply**

Scholarship applications and all supporting documents are accepted between February 1 and noon on **March 12, 2021**.

***It is the scholarship applicant's responsibility to ensure that the packet is complete and on time. Failure to do so will void the application.***

### **Steps to Complete Application Process:**

The scholarship application consists of:

- Application (ONLINE only!)
- Official transcript
- Personal statement - The committee reviews this component very carefully in order to help match recipients with donor's intent.
- Two current letters of recommendation (one academic and one character)
- All military applicants must provide their DD214.
- All art scholarship applicants must provide a portfolio to be turned in at the Spirol Art Gallery by March 12.
- All supporting documents must be submitted in one packet at the Atrium Security Desk in Danielson. Willimantic students may make arrangements with Maria Garcia-Alvarez: 860.230.6129, [mgarcia@qvcc.edu](mailto:mgarcia@qvcc.edu)

### **How Scholarships are Awarded**

Scholarship applicants are screened by an impartial committee from the QVCC Foundation. Recipients will be notified by members of the QVCC Foundation by May 5.

2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be a recent high school graduate
4. Have demonstrated financial need

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC

*Preference to: Applicants who, despite significant personal obstacles, are making gains in their pursuit of higher education*

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better

*Preference to: Students coming from difficult family situations, broadly defined, either financial or emotional*

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be working toward a degree in the College of Technology

2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be female

### **Northeast Connecticut Arts Council Scholarship (2 @ \$1,000)**

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be enrolled in a QVCC Fine Arts program
4. Be recommended by a faculty member with first-hand knowledge of the applicant's artistic talent and promise

### **Northeastern Connecticut Chamber of Commerce Scholarship (2 @ \$1,400)**

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be a resident of the greater Windham County region

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be a resident of northeast Connecticut

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be enrolled in a College of Technology AS degree in Technology Studies (not plastics) or Engineering Science

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be a resident of Thompson, Conn.

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be enrolled in the Early Childhood Education program

## **Steven & Marjolaine '87, '88 Townsend Scholarships**

Applicant must:

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC. If part-time, must be enrolled in two or more classes.
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or better
3. Be a resident of Ashford, Brooklyn, Canterbury, Chaplin, Eastford, Hampton, Killingly, Plainfield, Pomfret, Putnam, Sterling, Thompson, Willimantic or Woodstock.
4. Take the majority of classes at the Danielson campus, 742 Upper Maple Street.
5. If applying for the Fine Arts scholarship, submit a portfolio containing 3 pieces of art with the entire application. Portfolios will be judged by a professional impartial panel.

Applicant must:

1. Be a full or part-time student
2. Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
3. Must be a resident of Putnam and graduating from Putnam High School in the spring of this scholarship application period.

1. Be a full-time or part-time student at QVCC
