The Commission, at its January 2021 meeting, reviewed your application for an initial grant of Medical Laboratory Technology programmatic accreditation, including the Self-Evaluation Report, the on-site visit reports, and the response to the reports. Based on review and discussion, the Commission acted to grant initial programmatic accreditation through **February 28, 2024.**

In determining the length of the grant, the Commission considered the overall evaluation process of the program, including that this is an initial grant. The grant length encourages the program's focus on maintaining compliance and reflection on improvements that can be achieved prior to the next comprehensive review.

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Education's December 11, 2020, guidance related to COVID-19 flexibilities, a limited in-person accreditation site visit to the institution is required. An ABHES representative will conduct the visit and will be in contact with you to provide notice of the schedule and other details once in-person visits have resumed. We expect all visits to take place within 180 days following a declaration that the COVID-19 national emergency has ended.
