Who Can Apply

Scholarships are available to students attending QVCC (home campus) in the 2023-2024 academic year. All students are encouraged to apply, including:

- New, Returning, or Transferring
- Self-pay or Financial Aid
- PACT
- Full Time or Part Time (enrolled in two or more classes)
- Most scholarships require a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Applicants should carefully review individual scholarship criteria

Where to Get an Application

When to Apply

Scholarship applications and all supporting documents are accepted between February 1 and noon on March 10, 2023.

It is the scholarship applicant's responsibility to ensure that the packet is complete and on time. Failure to do so will void the application.

Steps to Complete Application Process:

The scholarship application consists of:

- Application (ONLINE only!)
- Official transcript
- Personal statement - The committee reviews this component very carefully in order to help match recipients with donor's intent.
- Two current letters of recommendation (one academic and one character)
- All military applicants must provide their DD214.
- All art scholarship applicants must provide a portfolio to be turned in at the SPIROL Art Gallery by March 10.
- All supporting documents must be submitted in one packet at the Office of Student Development, Room E233 at QVCC's Danielson Campus. Willimantic students may submit packets at Winthrop Hall (ECSU) Monday through Thursday 9:00 – 7:00 pm and Fridays 9:00 – noon, and Windham Tech's Library Monday through Thursday 4-8 pm.

How Scholarships are Awarded

Scholarship applicants are screened by an impartial committee from the QVCC Foundation. Scholarship awards are presented at the QVCC Foundation Scholarship Night on Wednesday, May 3, at 5:00 pm (rain date May 4). Recipients are notified in advance of the ceremony and are required to attend to receive their awards.

Preference to: Students coming from difficult family situations, broadly defined, either financial or emotional

5. If applying for the Fine Arts scholarship, submit a portfolio containing 3 pieces of art with the entire application. Portfolios will be judged by a professional impartial panel.
