## **Application Process**

- Is there a GPA requirement? Are there program specific GPA requirements?
- Are ACT/SAT scores required?
- How do you evaluate transfer applicants?
- Are transfer students are accepted each semester? If so, how many?
- Are any specific application materials required? (ex. essay, interview, portfolio, audition)
- When is the deadline for transfer applicants (fall and spring)?
- Are there any additional admissions requirements for my specific program?



**Finances** 

- When is the deadline for financial aid?
- Are there work-study positions available for transfer students?
- What scholarships/grants are available?
- What is the cost of attendance for one year?



**Academics** 

- How many of my credits will be applied to my major?
- How many transfer credits are accepted?
- Are there online/evening/weekend courses?
- Are there opportunities to study abroad?
- Will I have an assigned faculty advisor? Academic advisor?
- What is the student to instructor ratio?
- How will the college help me stay on track to graduate on time?



## Campus & Community

- Where is the campus located? (i.e. rural, urban, suburban)
- What amenities are nearby? (ex. shopping centers, medical care)
- Is public transportation available? Is there transportation on campus?
- Are students required to live on-campus?
- What options exist for transfer student housing?
- What clubs and organizations are active on campus? Are there any groups specifically for transfer students? Commuter students?
- How does the college support its commuter population?
- What does safety and security look like on this campus?



- Where can students go for assistance with assignments?
- What health resources are accessible to students?
- Can I join athletics? Are there open gyms on campus?
- What resources are available to me? (ex. counseling center, food pantry, disability/accessibility services, etc.)
- Are there career development and job placement opportunities?
